WHEREAS: Elwood R. "Woody" Bissett began his thirty-seven year career in law enforcement on January 1, 1950, as a patrolman with the St. Cloud, Minnesota, Police Department; and

WHEREAS: Woody Bissett was promoted to lieutenant on July 1, 1957, and in 1963, the title was changed to captain; and

WHEREAS: Woody Bissett was promoted assistant chief on April 18, 1975; and

WHEREAS: Chief Bissett, during his thirty-seven years of service to the citizens of St. Cloud, was an active community leader in numerous community affairs; and

WHEREAS: Chief Bissett was instrumental in the formation of the very successful tri-county major crime unit in 1978; and

WHEREAS: Chief Bissett has distinguished himself and his profession by giving of himself many tireless hours with the Governor's Crime Commission, the Stearns County Chiefs of Police Association, the Paul Bunyan Peace Officers Association and the Minnesota Chiefs of Police Association;
