WHEREAS: The United States Merchant Marine has served America with pride and honor since before the Revolutionary War; and

President John Adams stated in his memoirs, "No group of individuals did more for

establishing our country than the American merchant seamen and privateers. Their record speaks eloquently of their devotion and sacrifices"; and

WHEREAS: The United States Merchant Marine sacrificed much as they gallantly accomplished their

missions during World War II; and

WHEREAS: In World War II more than 6,700 merchant mariners lost their lives, more than 700

merchant ships where sunk, and more than 600 merchant mariners were held as prisoners

of war; and

Offical Coast Guard figures indicate that 43 merchant mariners from Minnesota died and WHEREAS:

one was held as prisoner during World War II; and
