



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *Networking Together* was established in 1980 by the U.S. Department of Labor Women's Bureau as a non-profit organization to foster support and communication among minority women by providing a platform to address issues of economic concern; and

WHEREAS: Region V consists of six states wherein *Networking Together* informs women of economic, educational, governmental and business resources available; and

WHEREAS: *Networking Together* Region V sponsors annual conferences targeting socioeconomic concerns of Black, Asian, Hispanic and American Indian women; and

WHEREAS: *Networking Together VII: A Minority Women's Employment Conference* will be hosted by the Minnesota chapter of the Minority Women's Employment Network on August 8-10, 1986, at the Minneapolis Plaza Hotel; and

WHEREAS: This three-day seminar will be an opportunity to define and ascertain workable solutions in the following areas: childcare, employment, family violence, teenage pregnancy, economic development, education and aging;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 8 through 10, 1986, to be
