WHEREAS: Bais Chana Women's Institute was established in St. Paul, Minnesota, sixteen years ago by the Upper Midwest Regional Office of the World Lubavitch Movement; and

WHEREAS: Since the establishment of Bais Chana more than four thousand Jewish women from throughout the world have come to Bais Chana to study Judaism; and

WHEREAS: The great success of Bais Chana has projected Minnesota on the world map of Jewish education by its being the only national/international Jewish institution in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: August 20 is the date on the Jewish calender which celebrates Jewish womanhood;
