WHEREAS: The National Association of Minority Contractors of Minnesota is a trade association formed to promote opportunities for minority businesses involved in construction and construction related activities; and


WHEREAS: The National Association of Minority Contractors of Minnesota Foundation has been created to provide support services to minority businesses engaged in construction and construction related endeavors;

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MINORITY CONTRACTORS OF MINNESOTA WEEK


in Minnesota.
