§ 490.121, SUBDS. 13 AND 14.


WHEREAS, the Honorable Paul J. Doerner, Judge of District Court,
Seventh Judicial District, State of Minnesota, has submitted his writ-
ten application for a disability retirement, by letter dated July 18,
1986, said retirement to be made effective the last day of the month
after which the governor determines that a judge suffers from a disa-
bility.

District Court since August 20, 1974; and


WHEREAS, the said Honorable Paul J. Doerner has satisfied the
necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes
Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of busi-
ness of August 31, 1986.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter
490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Paul
J. Doerner, Judge of District Court, Seventh Judicial District, State
of Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on August 31, 1986.
He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation
provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490. I hereby
direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of
State of the State of Minnesota.
