WHEREAS: More than 80 percent of all high schools in the State of Minnesota administer the ASVAB; and

WHEREAS: The ASVAB is offered by the Department of Defense without cost or obligation to students and school districts, while maintaining one of the best vocational aptitude indexes in the country; and

WHEREAS: The American Association for counseling and development has been instrumental in the preparation of useful information regarding the integration of the ASVAB in school guidance and career counseling programs; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has a responsibility to facilitate career exploration opportunities that will enable students to determine their educational and vocational goals;
