WHEREAS: One Minnesota citizen in 200 is estimated to carry double genes that cause accumulation of excessive iron resulting in disease of the liver, heart, sex glands, pancreas and the joints with ultimate death if untreated; and

WHEREAS: Our state's carrier rate of the single hemochromatosis gene is estimated at 13 percent; and

WHEREAS: Many doctors and their patients are not aware of this high incidence;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 21, 1986, to be
