



Proclamation

WHEREAS: All levels of government have a fundamental responsibility to safeguard the health of their citizens; and

WHEREAS: Both state and local government are strongly committed to the task of meeting this vital responsibility here in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The state of Minnesota has formally recognized this sharing of responsibility for the public health by passing the Community Health Services Act of 1976, which provides for a working partnership between state and local health agencies; and

WHEREAS: Community health agencies in all 87 counties of the state have chosen to become part of this unique state and local public health partnership and to take an active role in protecting and promoting the health of their citizens; and

WHEREAS: 1986 marks the tenth anniversary of the passage of the Community Health Services Act; and

WHEREAS: State and local officials, joined by public health professionals and others in the public health community, will hold their Annual Community Health Conference, September 10 through 12, 1986; and

WHEREAS: This conference will provide participants with an opportunity to share information and strategies so they can enhance the effectiveness of programs to help Minnesotans avoid preventable disease, injury, disability and death, and to lead safe, healthy and satisfying lives;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week of September to be
