WHEREAS: The National Adolescent Conference on Behavior Disorders will be held in Bloomington, Minnesota on September 14-16, 1986; and

WHEREAS: This conference will bring together teachers, administrators, trainers, researchers, psychologists, social workers, therapists, health professionals, parents, community agencies and correctional professionals to exchange and share information pertinent to the needs of adolescents with behavior disorders;
