WHEREAS: The Legislature has determined that overall policy is best accomplished by granting public employees the right to organize and choose freely their representatives; and

WHEREAS: For 40 years state employees have exercised these rights and fulfilled these responsibilities by organizing as a part of AFSCME Council 6; and

WHEREAS: Today, Thursday, October 2, 1986, AFSCME Council 6 celebrates its 40th Anniversary as a partner with the Governor of Minnesota and the Minnesota State Legislature in providing public services to the people of this state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second day of October to be


AFSCME COUNCIL 6 STATE EMPLOYEES DAY
