WHEREAS: Halloween, October 31, is a holiday especially for children and is recognized as National UNICEF Day; and

WHEREAS: The United Nations Children's Fund will celebrate 40 years of devoted service to improving the lives and health of millions of children in developing countries of the world; and

WHEREAS: UNICEF's international message of goodwill and friendship manifests itself in clean water, good nutrition, immunization, and educational opportunity; and

WHEREAS: National UNICEF Day is an opportunity for every American to show support for UNICEF's admirable humanitarian service by being generous to UNICEF Trick-or-Treaters and participating in local UNICEF benefit activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the thirty-first day of October to be
