



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Gerald Willet, a Park Rapids businessman, was elected to the Minnesota State Senate in 1970; and

WHEREAS: Gerald Willet was re-elected in 1972, 1976, 1980 and 1982, serving the people of Senate District #4 for 13 years; and

WHEREAS: Through the years Senator Willet has served as a chairman of the Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee and the Finance Committee, as vice chairman of the Local Government Committee, and as a member of the Elections and Ethics Committee and the Rules and Administration Committee; and

WHEREAS: Senator Willet has served as a member of the Legislative Advisory Commission, Legislative Commission on Employee Relations, Legislative Commission on Minnesota Resources and the Legislative Audit Commission; and

WHEREAS: Senator Willet's most important legislative accomplishments include the passage of the Forest Management Act of 1982, the Payment in Lieu of Tax Bill which passed in 1979, and the Outdoor Recreation Act of 1975;
