NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twenty-fourth day of October to be

UNITED NATIONS DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-six, and of the State the one hundred twenty-

eighth.
