WHEREAS: The United Nations Organization was established on October 24, 1945, at the end of World War II; and

WHEREAS: The year, 1986 is the 41st year in this turbulent world without devastating catastrophe of a third world war; and

WHEREAS: The existence of the United Nations Organization in this current year has been the structure that brought the superpowers, the U.S.A. and the U.S.S.R., into direct communication and negotiation at the highest level, including the "Summit"; and

WHEREAS: There is a growing recognition of the need for both continuity and improvement of the United Nations Organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twenty-fourth day of October to be

UNITED NATIONS DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-six, and of the State the one hundred twenty-eighth.
