WHEREAS: Gerald Kittridge was appointed to the Minnesota State Patrol in 1952, was promoted from trooper to sergeant in 1961, to captain in 1964, and to assistant chief in 1973; and

WHEREAS: After his retirement from the state patrol in 1980, Gerald Kittridge went on to teach police officer courses in institutes around the country; and

WHEREAS: Gerald Kittridge became the executive director of the Minnesota Police and Peace Officers Association in 1981, accepting the responsibility of representing more than 6,000 police officers; and


WHEREAS: Through his 34 year career in law enforcement, Gerald Kittridge has protected the citizens of Minnesota, shared his outstanding skills with others and looked after the best interests of his fellow officers;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, August 25, 1986, to be
