WHEREAS: The enhancement and protection of eyesight are of vital importance to all; and

WHEREAS: As allied health professionals, the opticians of the State of Minnesota are proficient in the field of optics for correcting vision problems; and

WHEREAS: Opticians maintain a high level of competence through continuing education; and

WHEREAS: Opticians use their skill, training and knowledge to provide eyewear of the highest quality within the means of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS: November will be observed as National Opticians Month under the auspices of the Opticians Association of America to call public attention to the important role of the dispensing optician in providing vision correction aids and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November to be
