WHEREAS: Cindy Nelson, a native born Minnesotan, has represented the United States of America for 14 years as a member of the U.S. Ski Team and has accumulated 1,353 World Cup points and seven U.S. National titles; and

WHEREAS: She has been a member of our nation's Olympic team four times and is recognized as the foremost American woman in the history of the alpine ski sport and has contributed both as an athlete and as an articulate spokesperson; and

WHEREAS: She has brought great honor to her native state and is to be honored on November 15, 1986, at the Minneapolis Auditorium;
