WHEREAS:

December 31, 1986, concludes the International Year of Peace; and

WHEREAS:

People all around the world are committed to peace in our lifetimes and have agreed to simultaneously unite in a sincere effort for peace; and

WHEREAS:

A multi-faith, multi-culture, non-political hour of worldwide thought/contemplation, prayer/meditation has been scheduled for 12:00 noon Greenwich Meantime on December 31, 1986; and

WHEREAS: The people of the State of Minnesota will have the opportunity to participate in this global event at 6:00 a.m. at the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the thirty-first day of December to be

PEACE IS POSSIBLE NOW DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-six, and of the State the one hundred twentyeighth.
