STATE OF MINNESOTA DEPARIMENT OF ADMINISTRATION REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 142

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1986, Section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the Governor's Washington Office with all its powers and duties for economic development and international trade are transferred from the Governor's Office to the Department of Energy and Economic Development.

Consistent with this transfer of authority, the following positions and their incumbents, with all accrued benefits, are transferred from the Governor's Office to the Department of Energy and Economic Development in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1986, Section 15.039.

The general fund complement of the Department of Energy and Economic Development as provided by Iaws 1985, First Special Session, Chapter 13, is increased by three positions.

The Governor's Office shall give to the Department of Energy and Economic Development all grants, contracts, books, plans, paper, records, and necessary equipment, furnishings and supplies relating to the transferred activities that are within the control of the Governor's Office.

Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 16B.37, subdivision 3 (1986).

The effective date of this order is January 12, 1987. The order is herewith filed with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.



WHEREAS, at the meeting of the County Board of Commissioners on December 23rd, 1986 the Board did issue the following order, to-wit:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That congressional township 142 north, range 39, west of the 5th principal meridian is hereby withdrawn from Maple Grove Township and organized as an individual township to be known as Eagle View, Becker County, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the following division of funds, after payment of all debts incurred previous to this order, shall be 61% to Maple Grove Township and 39% to Eagle View Township.
