WHEREAS: Curling will be a demonstration sport in the 1988 Olympics in Calgary Alberta with potential medal status in 1992; and

WHEREAS: This is the first U.S. Olympic Curling Playdown and will be the first Olympic curling competition since 1932; and

WHEREAS: The St. Paul Curling Club has been selected as the host for the 1988 U.S. Olympic Demonstration Curling Playdowns; and

WHEREAS: The Olympic Playdowns will take place April 8-12, 1987 at the St. Paul Curling Club;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of April to be
