WHEREAS: Licensed practical nursing is an art and science which shall continue to endure and be dedicated to quality care through the promotion of health, prevention of illness, and the care of the ill, aged and infirmed; and

WHEREAS: Licensed practical nurses observe, assess, admit, plan, give nursing care, maintain health and well being, and supervise as is commensurate with their education and demonstrated competence;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the last week of April to be

in Minnesota.
