WHEREAS:	America's men and women have served their country heroically since the Revolutionary
	War; and
WHEREAS:	Thousands of Americans have suffered wounds, loss of limb, not only on the battlefield
	but also in prisoner of war camps, preserving the freedom that we have today; and
WHEREAS:	This nation now enjoys the blessings of peace because of its veterans and their
	dedication to duty, honor and sacrifice; and
WHEREAS:	On March 2, 1887, the Minnesota Legislature established the Minnesota Veterans Home to
	honor all veterans and to commemorate their sacrifices in all American wars;

WHEREAS: Minnesota wishes to continue to honor its veterans;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the year 1987 to be

MINNESOTA VETERANS HOME CENTENNIAL YEAR

in Minnesota, and I urge all citizens to join in honoring our veterans.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Winnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the State the one hundred twenty-eighth.
