WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota enjoys the highest quality of life in the United States due, in part, to the exceptional health care delivery system; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota paramedics, as a part of this health care system, are highly trained professionals who in cooperation with emergency medical technicians, nurses, physicians and first responders serve the pre-hospital medical needs of Minnesota citizens throughout the state; and

WHEREAS: There are 32 advanced life support ambulance services staffed by nearly 800 paramedics who respond to 135,000 requests per year based through fire, community, police, hospital and military operations; and


WHEREAS: The dedication of these individuals in difficult and often life-threatening circumstances have earned them the gratitude and recognition of the public;
