WHEREAS: Much modern technology is dependent on the use of highly developed plastic materials; and

WHEREAS: Plastics play an important role in social and economic progress for Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: There are approximately 491 companies in our plastics industry and the number of Minnesota citizens working within our plastics industry exceeds 23,000; and

WHEREAS: The total annual value of shipments of plastics products produced in Minnesota exceeds \$2.3 billion; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Chapter of the Society of the Plastics Industry is this week hosting a plastics industry exhibit for legislators and government officials February 11th; and

WHEREAS: The plastics industry's contribution to the present and future economic well-being of Minnesota is vital and significant;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week of February to be

PLASTICS WEEK

in Minnesota.
