WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Branch of the YMCA was founded in 1887 to provide spiritual and other supportive services to University students; and

WHEREAS: The U-YMCA has effectively pursued the goal of challenging students to develop commitments to others and to the principles of social justice and personal morality; and

WHEREAS: The efforts of the U-YMCA is commemorating its one hundred years of service with a variety of events beginning with Founder's Day, February 12, 1987 and continuing throughout the year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twelfth day of February to be

UNIVERSITY YMCA DAY

in Minnesota.
