WHEREAS: Women have made important contributions to society which have been obscured in the telling of history; and

WHEREAS: The multicultural study of women's history would highlight the contributions and impact of all groups of women throughout our history and the inspirational value of these women for people of today; and

WHEREAS: The U.S. Congress has officially declared March 2 through 8, 1986, to be Women's History Week as a continuing public reminder of the significance of women as makers of history;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of March to be

W O M E N ' S H I S T O R Y W E E K

in Minnesota.
