



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Most of those suffering brain injuries face a lifetime of medical problems associated with paralysis, allergies, speech and vision problems, and memory failures; and
- WHEREAS: A Chance To Grow, a Minnesota, non-profit parent self-help organization which seeks healing, not the status quo, for the brain-injured individuals in Minnesota and the midwest, advocates the funding of central nervous system research for walking, talking and thinking, and active physical and speech therapy that can reverse many of the debilitating effects of a brain injury; and
- WHEREAS: A Chance To Grow believes that a brain-injured individual's family and their surrounding community offer the best therapeutic environment for supporting that person through the difficult journey through wellness; and
- WHEREAS: A Chance To Grow sponsors the Josephine Kretsch Library on Brain Injury, a layman's library on brain injury information to assist victims and their families in understanding this trauma; and
- WHEREAS: A Chance To Grow publishes an annual newspaper containing medical information pertaining to all brain-injured individuals and personal stories from families with brain-injured children;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 26 through May 2, 1987, to be


A CHANCE TO GROW FOR THE BRAIN-INJURED WEEK
