



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Born Free program began in 14 schools and colleges in Minnesota ten years ago; and

WHEREAS: Born Free was one of the first educational programs designed to reduce stereotyping and expand career options for both men and women; and

WHEREAS: Born Free has extended its efforts to reduce stereotyping and define new roles and relationships for women and men to 46 states and several foreign countries; and

WHEREAS: While we are "born free" of stereotypes, there is still a need to build options, reassess norms, and free roles through educational equity;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 27 through May 1, 1987, to be

B O R N F R E E W E E K

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the State the one hundred twenty-eighth.
