



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The education of our children is one of the most important responsibilities undertaken by society; and
- WHEREAS: Public and private schools provide learning opportunities in a variety of subject areas, building from the foundation of each child's reading and math skills; and
- WHEREAS: Some children require special assistance to properly develop these critical reading and math abilities; and
- WHEREAS: Chapter 1 of the Education Consolidation and Improvement Act (formerly Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act) provides public and private school children with additional instructional materials and personnel to assist those students performing below grade level in reading and math; and
- WHEREAS: The effectiveness of Chapter 1 programs is enhanced by parental involvement and public understanding of Chapter 1 objectives and methods;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 26 through May 2 to be
