WHEREAS: Child abuse touches us all, directly or indirectly, and the costs are enormous; and

WHEREAS: Child abuse is occurring with greater frequency in Minnesota than most people realize; and

WHEREAS: Violent behavior toward children can be modified when people accept responsibility for their actions and seek alternative ways to deal with stress and anger; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is a state that has many resources to assist people who are willing to reach out for help; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Chapter of the National Committee for the Prevention of Child Abuse has prepared campaigns to prevent violence toward children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April to be

CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

in Minnesota, and I urge every citizen to support this campaign; thereby evolving an era of family harmony in this state.
