WHEREAS: Courage Auxiliary's 475 members have raised more than \$1.3 million to support Courage Center services; and


WHEREAS: Courage Auxiliary is celebrating its 15th anniversary of caring and commitment to the needs of children and adults with physical disabilities;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 10, 1987, to be

in Minnesota.


