WHEREAS: The use of incentives in business is a valid method of increasing employee productivity and enhancing the work environment; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Incentive Club is a non-profit group comprised of men and women who desire to improve understanding in the business community of the value of incentives, and promote and protect their effective and legitimate use; and
