



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler began his record of public service in 1945 by holding the office of city clerk; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler served as Mayor of Le Center for 13 years; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler served as chairman of such city and county organizations as the Le Center Planning Commission, Le Sueur County Overall Economic Development Commission, and Le Sueur County Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler served his community in such capacities as chairman of the Le Center United Fund, director of the Le Center Industrial Development Committee, founder and chairman of the Le Center Industrial Development Corporation, scoutmaster, and director of the Le Sueur County Fair Association; and
- WHEREAS: As chairman of the Le Center Housing Authority, he arranged for construction of Centennial Plaza, a Le Center senior citizen complex; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler has been a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church since 1937, was chairman of the church's building task force committee, and was a delegate to the American Lutheran Church Convention in 1986; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler has lived in Le Center since 1937; and
- WHEREAS: Miles Bowler's long and dedicated service to the people of Le Center should be publicly recognized;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 22, 1987 to be
