WHEREAS: Repressive regimes continue to exist in Central America and Southern Africa; and

WHEREAS: On March 29, 1987, many Minnesotans will gather together to commemorate the assassination of Archbishop Romero in El Salvador and the Sharpeville massacre in South Africa; and

WHEREAS: All citizens of Minnesota desire that peace and justice prevail in all areas of the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 29, 1987, to be

PEACE AND JUSTICE DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the State the one hundred twenty-eighth.
