- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center has operated in Minneapolis since 1927; and
- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center annually provides medical care for over 16,000 hospitalized patients and treats over 230,000 veterans on an outpatient basis; and
- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center serves an area of 52 counties in Minnesota, 16 counties in Wisconsin and two counties in Iowa with a veteran population of over 525,000; and
- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center ministers to veterans of World War I, World War II, the Korean and Vietnam conflicts; and
- WHEREAS: The 60th Anniversary of the Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center is being celebrated on April 9, 1987;
