STATUTES, SECTION 490.121, SUBD. 13 AND 14.


WHEREAS, the Honorable John F. Dablow, Judge of District

business on April 30, 1987.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of  
Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota  
Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of  
the Honorable John F. Dablow, Judge of District Court, Tenth  
Judicial District, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be made  
effective on April 30, 1987. He shall become entitled thereafter  
to such retirement compensation provided under the provisions of  
Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be

Minnesota.
