ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF EITZEN, HOUSTON COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA, TERRITORY ABUTTING ON SAID CITY PURSUANT TO THE  
PROVISIONS OF SECTION 414.033, MINNESOTA GENERAL STATUTES  
AS AMENDED

The City Council of the City of Eitzen, Houston County, Minnesota,  
ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Hillery Robert Kasten and Lila Jane Kasten, husband and wife,  
being the sole owners of record of the real estate hereinafter described, duly  
petitioned the City Council of the City of Eitzen to have said real estate annexed  
to and included within said City, and

WHEREAS, Said real estate abuts on said City, is not included in any  
other municipality, is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area, and

WHEREAS, The annexation of said real estate hereinafter described to  
said City will be in the best interest of said City, of said real estate, and  
of the territory affected thereby, said real estate being of an urban character,


NOW, THEREFORE, Pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.033, Minnesota  
General Statutes, as amended, due notice of Petition for Annexation in the within  
matter having been served and there being no objection in the matter, it is hereby  
declared that the hereinafter described real estate is hereby annexed to, included  
within and made a part of the City of Eitzen, Houston County, Minnesota, said real  
estate being situate in said County and is described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter  
of Section 32, Township 101 North, of Range 5 West of the Fifth  
Principal Meridian, being a point on the centerline of the public  
road, thence South 16 rods, thence West 40 rods, thence North  
16 rods to the center of the public road, thence East along  
the centerline of the public road to the place of beginning,  
EXCEPT public right of way, and EXCEPT a tract described as com-  
mencing at the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of said  
Section 32, thence South 120 feet, thence West 120 feet, thence  
North 120 feet to the center of the public road, thence East  
along the center of the public road 120 feet to the place of  
beginning.




