WHEREAS: So many children are now growing up in single parent families; and

WHEREAS: So many of those same children are now or will be living at or below poverty level; and

WHEREAS: So many of those children are not being supported by both capable parents; and

WHEREAS: Non-support usually means non-visitation; and

WHEREAS: Many of those children are being forced onto welfare rolls; and

WHEREAS: On April 27, 1987, a candle light vigil will be held "To Lite a Spark in the Heart of non-payers to support their children;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 27 to be

CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS DAY

in Minnesota.
