NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of May to be




in conjunction with Richard Pittman Week, Thomas Curtis Week, and Michael Hall Week. I also proclaim May 2 to be


LOYALTY DAY
