NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of May to be




in Minnesota, in conjunction with Richard Pittman Week, Thomas Curtis Week, and David Weiss Week. I also proclaim May 2 to be

### L O Y A L T Y D A Y


in Minnesota.
