WHEREAS: Earls Court, the premier exhibition venue in London, England, has granted Buffalo Bill Cody the privilege of placing a bronze plaque honoring a United Citizen in a prominent location in the Great Facility; and

WHEREAS: That United States Citizen, William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody did make 49 appearances in the great State of Minnesota, thus making it a part of the network of 1132 the United States and parts of Europe; and

WHEREAS: This United States Citizen is remembered as the "Father of the Roden," the International Star" and an outstanding "Good-will-ambassador-at-large" for the States of America; and
