WHEREAS: The Minnesota Music Academy makes a significant contribution to the music industry in Minnesota; and


WHEREAS: The Minnesota Music Academy will present the 1987 Minnesota Music Awards on April 23, 1987;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 23 to be


