



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The economic well-being of this state and of this nation is dependent upon a sound transportation system; and

WHEREAS: The transportation policies implemented by state and federal regulatory bodies have provided this country with the most efficient transportation services that exist anywhere; and

WHEREAS: The impressive growth of the various modes of transportation has been in response to the public's ever-increasing demands for specialized, flexible, low-cost, efficient transportation services to meet the changing business patterns of this century; and

WHEREAS: The military security of this country and of the world depends on the capacity of the transportation industry to move men, women, and material; and

WHEREAS: The men and women who constitute the work force of this vast transportation industry should be recognized for their outstanding contribution to the daily needs of every farm, home, and business in the communities of this state and this country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 10 through May 16 to be

NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION WEEK

and May 15 to be

NATIONAL DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY

in Minnesota.
