WHEREAS: Mr. Lawrence I. Kaiser has taught thousands of Jewish children as a member of the

faculty of the Talmud Torah of Minneapolis for nearly 60 years; and

After arriving from Poland in 1928 he joined the Talmud Torah faculty and earned degrees in sociology and educational administration from the University of Minnesota; and WHEREAS:

Following appointment as executive director in 1944, three schools have been built in response to the movement of the northside Jewish community; and WHEREAS:

He was instrumental in gathering an outstanding staff of teachers, development of well-integrated bus schedules and for gaining a world-wide reputation for excellence; WHEREAS:

From 1955 to 1960, Mr. Kaiser served as board member of the Jewish Council of Education and chairman of its northwest region; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: Mr. Kaiser and his wife, Sonja, have contributed immensely to the Jewish community;
