



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Mr. Lawrence I. Kaiser has taught thousands of Jewish children as a member of the faculty of the Talmud Torah of Minneapolis for nearly 60 years; and
- WHEREAS: After arriving from Poland in 1928 he joined the Talmud Torah faculty and earned degrees in sociology and educational administration from the University of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Following appointment as executive director in 1944, three schools have been built in response to the movement of the northside Jewish community; and
- WHEREAS: He was instrumental in gathering an outstanding staff of teachers, development of well-integrated bus schedules and for gaining a world-wide reputation for excellence; and
- WHEREAS: From 1955 to 1960, Mr. Kaiser served as board member of the Jewish Council of Education and chairman of its northwest region; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Kaiser has prepared over 24 national champions in the annual national Bible contest; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Kaiser and his wife, Sonja, have contributed immensely to the Jewish community;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 31 to be

LAWRENCE I. KAISER DAY

in Minnesota.
