WHEREAS: Pinchas Zukerman, one of the world's great violinists, violists and conductors, has served as music director of the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra since 1980; and

WHEREAS: Maestro Zukerman has greatly increased the national and international reputation of the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra, which is the only professional chamber orchestra in the United States performing a full 40-week season; and

WHEREAS: Maestro Zukerman has conducted and performed with the orchestra in hundreds of concerts, in many concert halls in the Twin Cities, in cities throughout Minnesota, America and the world; and

WHEREAS: Maestro Zukerman has made nine recordings with the SPCO on major recording labels, expanding the orchestra's international audience; and

WHEREAS: Maestro Zukerman has been directly responsible for the enormous artistic and organizational growth of the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra since 1980; and


WHEREAS: Maestro Zukerman has led the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra into the front rank of America's major orchestras;

PINCHAS ZUKERMAN DAY


in Minnesota.
