WHEREAS: He was founder of the Black Horizon Theatre In his native Pittsburgh, where many of

his earlier plays were produced; and

WHEREAS: He was playwright-in-residence at the Playwrights Center in 'linneapolis; and

His play, Ma Rainey's Black Bottom, won the New York Drama Critic's Award for best play in 1984; and WHER SAS:

WHEREAS: He has won the John Gafftner Playwright's Award for 1987; and

His play, <u>Fences</u>, has won the New York Drama Critic's Circle Award for best play of 1987, the <u>New York Outer Circle Critic's Award for 1987</u>, and the <u>Pulitzer Prize for Drama for 1987</u>; and WHEREAS:

WHERE AS: The Broadway production of Fences has received six Tony nominations for the 1987

season; and

WHEREAS: August Wilson is a resident of St. Paul; and

WHEREAS: Four of his plays have been produced by Penumbra of St. Paul; and
