WHEREAS: The City of Brighton, England, is the namesake of the city of New Brighton, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The City of New Brighton, Minnesota, is celebrating its Centennial year; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of New Brighton, Minnesota, wish to promote international good will and fellowship between Brighton, England, and the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: On April 24, 1987, the City of Brighton, England, will receive an official delegation from the City of New Brighton, Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 24 to be
