- WHEREAS: It is estimated that over 35 million Americans--about 17 percent of the U.S. population--cannot afford adequate health care; and
- WHEREAS: Many of these people are poor expectant mothers, the mentally ill, the chronically and terminally ill, and the victims of medical emergencies, who have few alternatives to seek the medical care that they need; and
- WHEREAS: The Carondelet Health Care Foundation has initiated a campaign to raise the funds to help provide quality health care for the medically indigent; and
- WHEREAS: The Carondelet Health Care Foundation will launch its effort with the Carondelet Charity Gala Saturday, April 4, at the International Market Square;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 4, to be
